

Resolutions having the force of Standing Orders.

Third Session, (Journal, p. 11)—That the Certificates of Lay Delegates to the Synod be immediately forwarded by the Chairman of the meeting at which they are elected, to the Secretary of the Synod, who shall examine them, and report to the Synod, when it assembles, the names of those duly elected.

Seventh Session, (Journal, p. 17)—That Notices of Motion to be submitted to the Synod, shall be sent to the Secretary at least one month previous to its annual meeting; that the Secretary shall cause such Notices to be printed in the order in which they are received, and forwarded to the members with the usual notice of the Synod meeting; and that Motions of which notice is thus given shall not necessarily exclude other Motions, but shall have priority of consideration.

Alteration in Article III. of Constitution.

Tenth Session, (Journal, p. 2)—That in order to entitle a Substitute to sit in this Synod, the inability of the regularly elected Delegate to attend shall be certified by the Rector or Missionary in charge to the Secretary of the Synod, before such Substitute takes his seat.

The Secretary respectfully requests that the Certificates of the election of Lay Delegates be made out in the following form:
