Royal Charter Granted 1852.

The government of Trinity University is vested in the Corporation, composed of the Anglican bishops of Ontario, three trustees and the Council. The Council is made up of the chancellor, ex-chancellors, the provost and professors in arts and divinity in Trinity College, members nominated by the Bishops of Ontario and by each affiliated institution, and members elected by the graduates who are members of convocation.

The management of the finances and academic business of the University is entrusted to the Crown, the Board of Trustees, the Senate, Convocation, the University Council and the Council of University College.

The supreme authority in all matters is vested in the crown.

The Board of Trustees has general advisory powers in the financial affairs of the University; John Hoskin, LL.D, QC, chairman.

The Senate has the general management of the business of the University, the prescription of curricula, the examinations, etc., and consists of ex-officio members, appointed members and elected members. The ex-officio members are the Minister of

Education, the President of University College, the heads of each federated institution, and the past and present chancellors and vice-chancellors. The appointed members consist of representatives from the councils of the University and University College, from the federated or affiliated institutions, and nine members appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council. The elected members represent the graduates and the High School teachers of the Province.

Convocation consists of the whole body of graduates of the University, in all faculties. It elects the chancellor and members of the senate as its representatives in arts, medicine and law.
