

MINUTES OF THE MANITOBA AND NORTH-WEST CONFERENCE.

HELD AT WINNIPEG, JUNE 3RD, 1896.

THE MINISTERIAL SESSION OF THE MANITOBA AND NORTH-WEST CONFERENCE of the Methodist Church met in Grace Church, Winnipeg, on June 3rd, 1896, at 9 a.m.

The President of Conference, Rev. Dr. Maclean, announced Hymn 559; the Secretary, Rev. G. W. Dean, read the 6th chapter of Hebrews, and Revs. A. W. Ross and Thompson Ferrier led in prayer.

The roll of ministers was called, and sixty-five answered to their names.

Said commission met at Minnedosa, July 1st, 1895, and ordained Bro. L. D. Post for special purposes as directed by the Conference.
