GREAT CANAL FOR GERMANY

Big Ditch Connecting German Rhine With Sea COST ABOUT \$200,000,000

Believed It Would Prove of Enormous Benefit to Country in Peace or War—Holland Now Controls Commerce of the World

Berlin, July 28.—Germany wants to divert the mouth of the Rhine from Holland to her own territory. She wants to make a second mouth to the Rhine which will lie in German territory and thereby to cut out the Dutch and the Dutch port of Rotterdam, which at present has a monopolistic control of Rhine traffic and can stop all Rhine commerce in time of war.

ALFALFA IN CHARLOTTE

The question of the raising of alfalfa in this province is being discussed. It has already been established by experiment that under proper conditions alfalfa can be successfully grown in New Brunswick. Rev. Hunter Boyd, now of Glasgow took a deep interest in the subject while he was located at Waweg, and succeeded in developing some fine plants. He was satisfied that it could be grown here. One of our St. Andrews farmers, who spent some time in the west, also made an experiment of raising it here.
