PAROCHIAL CONSTITUTION.

1. This Association shall be called "The..... Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society of the Church of England in Canada."

2. The objects of this Branch shall be: To pray for missions; to aid the Woman's Auxiliary in its work of interesting church women in missionary work by one common bond of harmonized effort; to diffuse missionary intelligence and to infuse missionary zeal amongst the children of the Church; to receive contributions towards the funds of the Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society.

3. All women who desire to be members of this Association may become such by the payment of an annual subscription (from ten cents to one dollar), which fees shall be at the disposal of the Parochial Branch.

4. The Board of Management shall consist of a President, a Vice-President, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary and a Treasurer, together with two women nominated by the Rector of the Parish.

5. The Annual Meeting shall be held..... in April.

6. The Order of Business at the Meetings shall be:—

1. Prayer; 2. Minutes of the last Meeting; 3. Correspondence; 4. Treasurer's Report; 5. Offerings, (if so arranged); 6. Missionary intelligence and Miscellaneous Business.

7. Special Meeting at the request of two members.
8. This Constitution shall be voted at the Annual Meeting given at a previous meeting.

1. The President and Vice-Presidents, shall preside at the meetings.

2. The duty of the Secretary shall be to give notice of all meetings. She shall prepare the Annual Statement of the Diocesan Branch before the Diocesan Assembly.

3. The Corresponding Secretary shall report on the correspondence of the Branch.

4. The Treasurer shall report on the financial statement of the Branch, and shall also send to the Diocesan Treasurer all money and articles received. She shall present the Annual Report to be read at the meeting.

5. The board shall have a missionary spirit; and shall augment the fund by the efficiency of the way the efficiency of the objects of the Society, by visiting the objects of the Society, and by soliciting regular subscriptions.

6. In the interest of the Society, it should elect a lady, to perform any office, to represent the Diocesan Branch at the City Parochial Branch.

This lady may be elected at such such. She would be elected at the Diocesan Meetings or to other meetings, to advise her Branch and be prepared to give a report. (See final clause of constitution.)
