A BELGIAN TRAGEDY.

(From the New York Times.)
There has come to the attention of trustworthy Belgian sources a piece of German devilry that ought not to be concealed. From the small town of Otigen, between Brussels and Namur, the Germans deported several hundred men, whom they shipped to a distant part of Germany, where they were forced to work in mines and munition factories. They were subjected to horrible mental torture and vile physical abuse. Recently, in severe winter weather, a train of cattle trucks came slowly back to Otigen, carrying 117 of these poor men, broken down by cold, starvation, and excessive toil and no longer able to slave for their cruel taskmasters. They had been several days on the journey, without food and drink, and when the cars were opened and the human wrecks lifted out, in the midst of their weeping wives and children, seven of the number were found to be dead.
