An Act respecting the Federal Life Assurance Company of Ontario, and to change its name to the Federal Life Assurance Company of Canada.

WHEREAS the Federal Life Assurance of Ontario has, by Preamble its petition represented that it was incorporated by an Act of the legislature of the province of Ontario, being chap-Ont., 1874, ter 68 of the statutes of 1874, under the name of "The Induscial Life Assurance Company of Canada,"—that the said Act was amended by section 7, chapter 1 of the statutes of 1875,—that by an order of the Lieutenant-Gover Ont., 1875, nor of the said province, in council, dated the eleventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, the name of the said company was changed to "The Federal Life Assur-

- ance Company of Ontario," and that the said company duly obtained a license under The Insurance Act of Canada, bearing date the twenty-eighth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, and has since carried on the business of 15 life insurance in Canada; and whereas the said company has, by its petition, prayed that an Act be passed declaring it to be a body corporate within the jurisdiction of the Parliament of Canada, under the name of "The Federal Life Assurance Company of Canada," with the powers hereinafter set forth, 20 and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition:

 Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent
 of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, declares and
 enacts as follows:—
- 25 inafter called "the Company," as now organized and constituted under the statutes mentioned in the preamble, is hereby declared to be a body corporate and politic within the legislative authority of the Parliament of Canada; and this Act and The Insurance Act shall apply to the Company and 30 its business, instead of the said Acts of Ontario and the Acts of Ontario respecting insurance; provided that nothing in this section shall affect anything done, any right or privilege acquired, or any liability incurred under the above-mentioned Acts of Ontario up to and at the time of the passing of this 35 Act, to all of which rights and privileges the Company shall continue to be entitled, and to all of which liabilities the Company shall continue to be subject.
- 2. The name of the Company is hereby changed to "The Name Federal Life Assurance Company of Canada," but such change to in name shall not in any way impair, alter or affect the rights or liabilities of the Company, nor in anywise affect any suit
