BILL

An Act for taking and recording the Votes of Members of the Legislature on the final passage of Bills.

WHEREAS twenty Members are a quorum of the Legislative Preamble.

Assembly; and whereas it is desirable that the Votes of the Members of the Legislature upon the final passage of Bills should be taken and recorded; Be it therefore enacted, &c.

5 That in the Legislative Council and in the Legislative Assembly, Votes to be the question upon the final passage of any Bill shall be taken the passing of immediately upon its last reading, and the yeas and nays entered every Bill. upon the Journal.
