An Act to impose Tolls on Vessels and Passengers brought down the St. Lawrence, past any of the Canals thereon.

WHEREAS it is expedient to impose Tolls on Ves- Preamble. sels and Passengers brought down the River St. Lawrence, past any of the Canals thereon : Be it therefore enacted, &c.

- 5 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, what Tolls That the same Tolls shall be payable on Steamboats or shall be pay-Vessels of any kind and Passengers, brought down the and passen-River St. Lawrence, past any of the Canals between gerk Montreal and Kingston, as would be payable on such
- 10 Steamboats, Vessels or Passengers, if the same had been brought through the Canal or Canals past which they shall have been brought down; and such Tolls shall be levied in like manner, and under the like penalties and forfeitures for the non-payment thereof.
- 15 II. And whereas doubts have been entertained as to Recital. the extent of some of the powers committed to the Governor in Council by the eighteenth Section of the Act passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "An Act to amend the Law constituting the 20 Board of Works," and it is expedient to remove such
- doubts : Be it therefore enacted, That it shall be lawful Regulations for the Governor in Council, by any regulation made and for the seizure published as by law required, to authorize the seizure of of vessels for any boat or vessel of any description, using any of the ^{non-payment} of Tolls, &c.
- 25 public works in the said Act mentioned, either for the non-payment of Tolls, or of any fine duly imposed, or of any sum demanded by the Superintendent, Engineer or person in charge of any such work as compensation for damage done, and further to empower the party making
- 30 such seizure to detain such vessel with her cargo and appurtenances at the risk of the owner or owners, until payment of such Toll, penalty or compensation as aforesaid; and it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to regulate the seizure and detention of any vessel and
- 35 cargo as aforesaid, by such rules and orders as to him may seem expedient.
