XIII. And be it further enacted, That One Moiety of all pecuniary Recovery and Penalties and Forfeitures hereby imposed, as far as the same relate to Penalties. Ships or Vessels sailing without Convoy, or wilfully separating or departing from such Convoy, or to Insurances, shall (if sued for within the Space of One Year from the Time of any fuch Penalty or Forfeiture being incurred) be to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, and the other Moiety thereof, with fuil Costs of Suit, to the Person or Persons who shall inform or sue for the same within the Time aforesaid, and which shall and may be sued for in any of His Majesty's Courts of Record at Westminster for Offences committed in England, or at Sea, or in Parts beyond the Seas, and in His Majesty's Court of Exchequer at Edinburgh for Offences committed in Scotland, by Action of Debt, Bill, Plaint, or Information, wherein no Effoin, Privilege, Wager of Law,
