

An Act to amend the Act to provide for the separation of the County of Peel from the County of York, and to enable the qualified Electors of the said County of Peel to select the County Town for that County.

**W**HEREAS it has been represented to the Legislature of this Province that difficulties have arisen in the working of the Act passed in the nineteenth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled "*An Act to provide for the separation of the County of Peel from the County of York*;" And whereas it is desirable that those difficulties should be removed so that the objects contemplated by the said Act may be fully and effectually carried out; And whereas for such purpose it is necessary that the fourth section of the said recited Act should be repealed; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

10 I. If the votes taken, in the manner specified by the third section of the said recited Act, shall have given a majority in favor of separation, then it shall be the duty of the qualified municipal electors of the said County of Peel, on the day and time in the manner pointed out in the next section of this Act, to declare at an election to be held for such purpose by a majority of votes, a place as and for the County Town of the said County; and the place so declared and nominated shall be the County Town of the County of Peel, and the Provisional Council mentioned in the second section of the said recited Act shall have and exercise the powers conferred on Provisional Municipal Councils by law, and shall purchase the necessary property at the place declared and nominated by such majority of the said qualified Municipal Electors as aforesaid, and proceed to erect or cause to be erected the necessary public buildings on such property, and all the provisions of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled "*An Act for abolishing the territorial division of Upper Canada into Districts, and for providing for temporary Unions of Counties for Judicial and other purposes, and for the future dissolutions of such Unions as the increase of wealth and population may require*," shall apply to the said provisional Municipal Council, and to the said County of Peel; Provided always, that the place to be declared and nominated as aforesaid shall be one of the following, namely, Brampton, Streetsville, Malton or Port Credit.

If the votes be in favour of separation the County Town to be also chosen by a majority of votes.

Proviso: it shall be one of certain places.

II. The day of one thousand eight hundred and shall be the day, and the same is hereby fixed for the holding of such election, and recording the votes of such qualified Municipal Electors as in the last preceding section is mentioned, and for the purpose of taking the votes at such election as aforesaid, a
