C A P. XVI.

An Act to enable His Majesty to authorise, in case of Necessity, the Importation of Bread, Flour, *Indian* Corn, and Live Stock, from any of the Territories belonging to the United States of *America*, into the Province of *Quebec*, and all the Countries bordering on the Gulf of *Saint Lawrence*, and the Islands within the said Gulf, and to the Coast of *Labrador*.



P R E A M B L E by an Act passed in the Preamble.
Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for regulating the Trade between the Subjects of His Majesty's Colonies and Plantations in *North America*, and in the *West India* Islands, and the Countries belonging to the United States of

America; and between His Majesty's said Subjects and the Foreign Islands in the *West Indies*; it is amongst other Things enacted, That no Goods or Commodities whatever shall be imported from any of the Territories belonging to the United States of *America*, by Sea, or Coastwise, into the Province of *Quebec*, or into the Countries or Islands within the Government thereof, or up the River *Saint Lawrence*, from the Sea, under the Penalty of the Forfeiture thereof, together with the Ship or Vessel importing the same, and all her Guns, Furniture, Ammunition, Tackle, and Apparel: And whereas it may be expedient, for the better Supply of the Persons employed in the Fisheries carried on, as well within the said Province, as in all the Countries bordering on the Gulf of *Saint Lawrence*, and on the Islands within the said Gulf, and also on the Coast of *Labrador*, that certain Sorts of Provision should be imported into the same from the Territories belonging to the said United States, when the Necessities of such Persons shall so require: Be it therefore enacted by the
