## CAP. XXV.

An Act to consolidate the laws relating to the Inspection of Fish and Oil in Upper and Lower Canada.

[Assented to 24th July, 1858.]

HEREAS it is expedient to amend and consolidate the Preamble. laws relative to the Inspection of Fish and Oil, and for the better regulating the curing and packing of Fish: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Act of the Legislature of Lower Canada, second Certain Acts Victoria, chapter sixty-five, -- the Act of the Legislature of this repealed. Province, thirteenth and fourteenth Victoria, chapter forty-three, 14 V. c. 43-3 and the Act of the Legislature of Upper Canada, third Vic- V. c. 24. toria, chapter twenty-four, are hereby repealed.
- 2. It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appoint Appointment Inspectors of Fish and Oil in the Districts of Quebec and Mont- and making real, in the Counties of Gaspé and Bonaventure and in the regulations. Magdalen Islands, respectively, and also in such Counties, Districts and localities respectively, in Upper and Lower Canada, as may be deemed most conducive to the interests and wants of each section of the Province; and to make from time to time all and every regulation that may be necessary, for better carrying out the provisions of this Act: and every such regulation, Regulations to being published in the Canada Gazette, shall, so far as it be published in Canada Gazette. may not be inconsistent with this Act or with law, have the zene. same effect as if it were inserted in this Act.
