

it shall be the duty of the Assessor of each Ward in the said City to return with the rent or assessment rolls to be made and returned under the authority of this Act, a true and correct list of the persons within his respective Ward and the Liberties attached thereto, who shall be liable to pay the said last-mentioned sum, and to give notice to the persons respectively who shall be so liable and placed upon the said list; and it shall be the duty of the Collector of each Ward respectively to collect and receive such sum and sums of money, and pay over the same in like manner as other monies to be levied and raised under the authority of this Act.

17. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if any person or persons rated or assessed, as in manner herein directed, shall refuse or neglect to pay the Rates or Assessments charged upon him, her, or them, for the space of fourteen days next after such rates shall be due and demanded by the Collector of the Ward in which the premises in respect whereof such person or persons shall be rated or assessed is situate, or in which such person or persons shall be resident, if not rated in respect of property, it shall and may be lawful for the said Collector to apply to the Mayor or one of the Aldermen of the said City for a warrant to the High Bailiff or any Constable of the said City, to enter into the house or houses, other dwellings, or premises of such person or persons, and to sieze and take possession of his, her, or their goods and effects, (whether in the Ward in which the assessed property is situate or elsewhere in the said City or Liberties,) which warrant the said
