This Saturday's game will undoubtedly be the most important match as Dal., the defending champs, come to play U.N.B. at home.

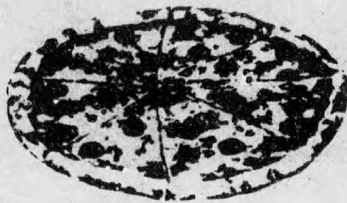
