It seems that the food service and hospitality industry is governed by trends that come and go.

Over the last few years I have noticed many trends that both came and went.

At the present time there seems to be two trends that are really having an impact on restaurants and taverns in the area.

The first trend is the exotic dancers. There are many clubs now that have dancers or 'strippers' to entertain patrons during the luncheon hours and in some cases after daily working hours and in the evening.

There are so many clubs that have these dancers that I could never begin to mention them all but I can tell you that the Monarch Steak House and Tavern on Albion Road at Highway 27 seems to hold the record for most girls and performances. The Monarch has continuous dancers from noon till 8 p.m. and employs an average of eight dancers daily.

Some people have said to me that they didn't think there was that many places with the dancers in this area. In answer to that comment, I can assure you that there are more taverns with the dancers than without them.

The other trend that is becoming very popular is family dining.

Although most places welcome children and do have a limited children's menu,

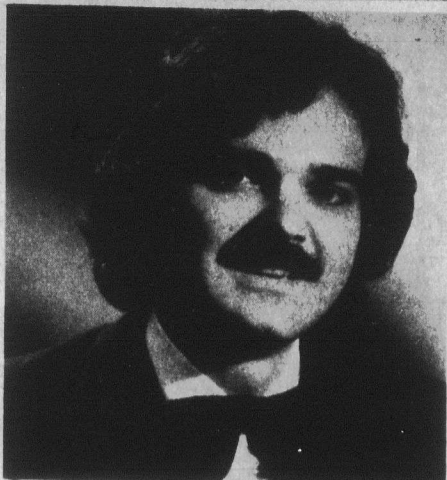
there are a few places that go all out for families and have priced their menus accordingly.

There are more and more of these type of restaurants available to the public daily but a few places stick in my mind as being among the best in this field. These places are the Windsurfer Family Sea Food House on the Queensway, Downing Square Family Restaurant on Dunblow, the Canadiana Restaurant in the Six Points Plaza and Sherway Forest Restaurant at the East Mall and North Queen.

These places all offer some full course meals for under \$5.00 per person with children's meals costing much less. The Windsurfer seems to lead the way in the salad department by offering a free salad bar during both lunch and dinner hours. Downing Square has a free salad bar during dinner each evening.

There are some fine dining rooms and steak houses in the area offering excellent cuisine in pleasant surroundings with some having entertainment but the public seems to have really jumped aboard the spots catering to family dining.

Don't forget that the Cambridge Hotel is offering psychic readings during lunch in Sadie's on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday all this week and next.
