With this end in vien I would suggest that a section 040 acres of land in each Undian Reserve be set apart as a model and Stock garmand that a skilful mana que be appointed to superintend the same. In selecting the site it would be necessary to choose a section sombable on account of do promity to now and naker for the proposes It might perhaps be difficult to seeme the services of a person capable of taking charge of such an undertaking one acquainted with the Judians and their language and at the same time a skilful agricultionst. accustomes to the rays of the country. Omployment would be goven the Sudians from the first establishment of such a farm in supplying materials for building and fencing perforces and afternais them nonto be employed Constantly on the farm, Being promptly pais for such services they nonlobe induced to do whatever was regimed ander the direction of the Superintendent It nouls also be part of the duties of the Superintendent to directe the Indians in planting and cultivating their own plots of land, and advise them as to the management of the same.
