Sir.

I return herewith the rules and regulations drawn up by the Chief and Council of the Cumberland Band, and which were received under cover of your letter of the 30 th of March last.

I am advised by the Department of Justice that the first and fourth clauses of the Regulation are ultra vires of the Chief in Council and cannot therefore be accepted.

you will observe that a few changes in the other clauses have been made and as amended are, I am advised within the law, and if passed will be capable of being enforced.

You will be good enough to cause the papers to be re-submitted to the Chief and Council with a view to the same being amended accordingly.
