Ottawa 4th May 1901-

Referring to Memorandum of the Deputy Minister of the 3rd Instant, I beg to say that I do not know of any recommendation having been made for providing timber land or wood for the Indians of the Fisher's Grant Reserve, County of Pictou, N.S.

Mr.Agent J.R.McDonald recommended in 1899
that an addition of 80 acres be purchased for this
Reserve at a cost of \$1200.00, but he expressly represented that this addition was required not for
wood purposes but to supply the Indians with more
arable land, of which, he stated, they were deficient.
There being no Funds, the purshase was not made.
