As corresponding changes in other parts of the world.
1st there is a great deal of imitation - going rise to heavier war-
material - Borden believed universal peace will follow
almost immediately on industrial unification, but it
seems as if industrial ^{unification} ~~unification~~ had been checked by
industrial concentrations. — We are of unification - you can
transport machinery each city can supply itself
to best methods, so you have concerted effort
on part of each city to develop its own supply.
You haven't the same recognized dependence
of one city on the other as before, ^{at least on a} each city ~~thought~~
thought it could outgrow other cities, & many
things do it - this has given rise to a new
commercial jealousy. — The limit to the
upward part of Russia to make these war-
material industrial centres has only been rendered
possible by age of industrial unification, effort to
imitate Eng. cover haul her on commercial side
just as Eng in 17th cty consciously sought to
overrun Holland by imitating her in shipping
etc, so in 19th cty & Russia there has been a
conscious imitation, to make them to imitate.
So the peace of food will be all over etc has
been true for Eng, but not true for other nationalities
