

I enclose a copy of a communication dated the 17th instant, from the Chiefs of the Sechelt Indians, complaining that land at Skeokum Cheek, on which their Indians have resided for a number of years, has been taken up by a half-breed by the name of Alfred Jeffrey, and have to request that you will lay this matter before the Commission for such action as they may consider necessary.

Our Indian Agent, Mr. P. Byrne, at New Westminster, has been furnished with a copy of the letter and instructed to give full information in the matter complained of when called upon to do so by the Commission.
