each feeding. Increase amount of Pard as required. At the age of three to four months, the feedings should be cut down to three daily, continuing to maturity—from 11 to 18 months—after which two feedings will suffice.

Pard for Cats

Cats will thrive on Pard. It gives them a healthy, well-cared-for appearance. Pard aids in producing the long "guard hairs" which protect the cat's coat. Pard is a complete food for cats—nothing else is needed to provide proper nourishment. For adults we recommend ½ to ½ can at each feeding—morning and afternoon. Kittens require four to five feedings daily—a teaspoon to a tablespoonful of Pard—mixed with milk—at each feeding. Increase as required.


