To note that Mr. T.L.Bonnah was promoted with effect from February 3, 1944, to the position of Indian Agent, Grade 3, for the St.Regis Indian Agency, Quebec.

While his promotional certificate reads that he is to receive a salary of \$1380. per annum, plus house, fuel and light, Mr.Bonnah is residing at Cornwall as the Indian Agent's residence on the St.Regis Reserve is not habitable at the present time.

It will, therefore, be necessary to pay Mr.Bonnah \$300. cash, per annum, in lieu of house, fuel and light. A staff questionnaire is attached hereto.
