Production of Documents

"Certain documents will now be produced by the prosecuting officer under para. 2.

Prosecuting Officer having been duly sworn states -"

I wish to produce the following documents which copies I have previously checked against the original documents

- (a) Medical certificate ^{physical} as to fitness of accused
(b) Certified true copy of the M.R.M.C. belonging to accused.
(c) Statement as to character and particulars of service of the accused.

Statement by the defending Officer in mitigation of punishment

"I wish to state that the accused is very young. He is at present only 20 years of age yet having served for four years in the Canadian Active Army he has been under the influence of several poor influences. In addition to this he was under the influence of liquor that evening and was most entirely responsible for anything he might have done. He was under a certain amount of strain due to present circumstances. He accused also wished me to say that if he were found guilty he wished to regain his unit as soon as possible so that the night fight for the cause in which it is now embarking."
