Gwazi, on Quatse river: Five acres recommended, if available, on the eastern back of Quatse river near its mouth, in Sec. 30 Tp. 6; Rupert Land District. NOTE: Under the Provincial Land Act no one may make application for lands long settled by Indians; the lands herein taken up are stated by the Agent to have been occupied for an are stated by the Agent to have been occupied for a second to the second to as an Indian village for upwards of 20 years.

Ak-la-nuzi island: Believed to be alienated. but recommended that the Indians for all time to come enjoy the right to dig clams on the foreshore.

Kluk-si-wi: Recommended that the Commission ascertain the status of land contained in the old "Government Reserve" (naval ?/) lying between Point McNeill and Broughton Strait, and if it is possible that lands therein can be secured for these Indians that they receive. 200 acres from the Government Reserve afore-
