Winnipeg. Trade here is a little more active, although mild weather continues to affect the demand for retail lines, but there is some compensation in the greater activity...

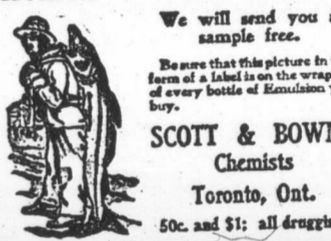
Quebec—Wholesale trade shows no improvement over that of the preceding week, and collections are generally slow...
