Our prayer, O Blessed Godhead, hear, O Father, Son and Holy Ghost, Be glory Thine from all the host That dwell upon this earthly sphere.

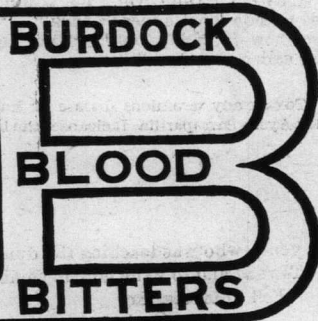
Lulworth Castle.

When the hierarchy was first established in the United States of America, November 10, 1789, John Carroll was named the first Bishop of America...

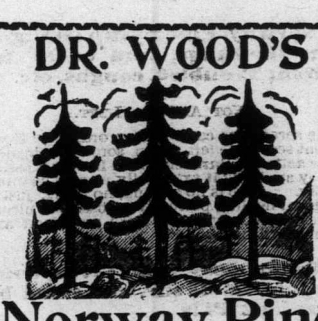
