commencement of the session of 1806, Even though I may be seventy-seven. President Jefferson asked of that body the wisdom of abolishing African slave trade. The message was referred to a select committee, which reported a bill to prohibit the importation of slaves into the United States. This bill, of course, was fought by the Southern representatives. A long and fiery debate ensued and the act was finally passed after several amendments, imposing a fine on persons engaged in the slave trade were added.

When did the emancipation of slav-

The emancipation of slaves in all the French colonies took place in 1794 and in the English colonies in 1838 and 1839. Sweden emancipated her slaves in 1846, Denmark in 1848. Holland delivered her American colonies from slavery in 1862. The African slave trade was closed in this country on the first day of January, 1862, followed by the Emancipation Proclamation January 1st 1863.
