

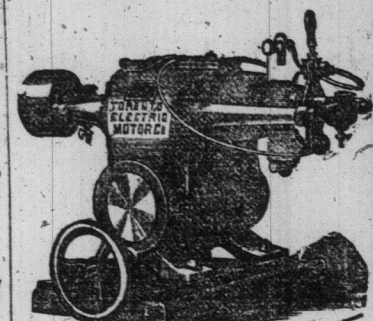

Flames Occasion a Loss of More Than Three-Quarters of a Million Dollars.

Many Wholesale Houses Burned to the Ground--The Fire Originated in the Osgoody Building in Melinda-Street, and Spread South to Wellington, Burning the Premises of Robert Darling, Boisseau & Co., Thomas Dunnett, R. H. Gray & Co. and Hart & Riddell--Buntin, Reid & Co., Wyld, Grasset & Darling Also Heavy Losers.

THE OSGOODY BUILDING.
The fire started in the Osgoody building, which was a large warehouse on Melinda-street. It was a three-story building, and was used for the storage of various goods. The fire started in the rear of the building, and spread rapidly towards the front.

THE SPREAD OF THE FIRE.

THE LOSS.
The loss was estimated at more than three-quarters of a million dollars. The Osgoody building was completely destroyed, and the other buildings were severely damaged.

The cause of the fire was a defective gas pipe in the Osgoody building. The gas pipe was leaking, and a spark from a stove ignited the gas.

WIBED OUTSIDE FOR HELP.
Oshawa, Oakville and Hamilton appeared to be the only places where help could be obtained.

Just before eight o'clock, when the blaze was at its height, and with every prospect of its rapidly spreading, the fire was wired to Oshawa, Oakville and Hamilton to send assistance possible.

Special train had been chartered to convey the city from Hamilton, and as the Ambition City firemen had their own cars at the station, telephone message was received that the job was willingly tendered was fortunately not required.

Chairman Anderson of the Oakville Fire and Light Committee had the road blocked to the village bus and on the way to the station within six minutes of receipt of the message. He received the same notice as the Hamilton men, all danger was past. The reflection was plainly visible in Hamilton, and the village, and Mr. Anderson, with a score of Oakville men, came down to see the fire.

The Caretaker's Story.
Edward Caven, the caretaker of Osgoody building, was interviewed by The World, when he gave a graphic description of the scene from the burning building. His story was as follows:
