The Bank Clearings at Toronto for July Canadian Securities are Very Dull. Local Grain Market Features—Provisions Active and Lower at Chicago—Latest Commercial News.

Canadian Pacific weaker, closing in London today at 53 5/8; St. Paul closed at 72 1/2, Erie at 10 3/4, Reading at 91 3/8 and N.Y.C. at 104 1/2.

Bank clearings at Toronto for July are \$28,328,600, as compared with \$26,772,221 in June, \$23,768,089 in July last year, and \$27,043,577 the same month of 1894.

The world's visible supply of wheat decreased 2,400,000 bushels the past week.

Bradstreet reports a decrease of 1,129,000 bushels east of the Rockies, and 274,000 bushels west, making total decrease of 1,403,000 bushels for the week.
