

## 5 Accommodation and Services

### Convention Facilities

Among the convention facilities located in Fukuoka City are 17 conference rooms which seat 500 or more people. Four of these have a capacity of 1 000 or more. There are four major exhibition halls, of which the largest is the Fukuoka Kokusai Center, capable of holding 10 000 guests and located 15 minutes from the airport.

### Interpretation Services

Outside Tokyo's metropolitan area, English and French are not widely understood. It is in the visitor's best interests to be able to communicate effectively, even though host companies may provide in-house interpretation. Good interpretation skills will avoid time-consuming misunderstandings.

Sometimes, a professional interpreter with experience in business communication can also give an objective assessment of discussions, especially when what was not said is just as important as what was.

Japan Travel Phone is a nationwide telephone service for assistance and travel information in English. The service, available from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, is toll free outside Tokyo or Kyoto. Outside the Tokyo and Kyoto districts dial 106 and ask the operator to place a collect call to "T.I.C." In Tokyo dial 3502-1461; in Kyoto dial 371-5649. Most major train stations have an English-language tourist information service, but French-language service is virtually non-existent.
