

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

67. The Committee to which a Private Bill may be referred shall report the same to the Senate, together with what amendments have been made in the preamble of the Bill, such alterations and additions as the report, and to be stated in the Report.

PROVISIONS OF ACTS

68. When the Committee on any Private Bill reports to the Senate that the Provisions of such Bill have been agreed to their satisfaction, they may also report the grounds on which they have arrived at such a conclusion, and any Bill so reported shall be placed in the Office of the Clerk under the special order of the Senate.

MEMBERS' SIGNATURES

69. The Committee shall also cause to be printed a printer's copy of the Bill, in which the Amendments and other matters shall be inserted with the initials of his name, the several provisions and clauses of the Bill, with the amendments which shall be proposed by the Clerk of the Senate, and the report attached to the Report.

FORM OF AMENDMENTS

70. The proposed Amendment may be proposed in any manner which shall be deemed proper.
