decided attention you have given to those particular objects, which I recommended to your more immediate confideration.

I observe with satisfaction the improvements which you have introduced into the Law for the better Regulation of the Militia, from which, as it is now modelled, we may confidently anticipate very important advantages; and I cannot but be deeply sensible of the unequivocal proof which you have given me of your considence, in the Provision which you have adopted for carrying it into effect.

Sincerely attached as I am to the Interests of the Province over which His Majesty has been pleased to place me, I cannot but derive pleasure from your uniform endeavours to promote them; a pleasure that is greatly augmented by the hope which I indulge that those endeavours will not fail to be acceptable to that most gracious Sovereign whose parental attention is constantly directed to the welfare of his Subjects in every part of his exemsive Dominions.
