PLANETS.

MERCURY will be in its greatest Eastern elongations March 13, July 11, and Nov. 9; greatest Western elongations, May 1, Aug. 25, and Dec. 15. When in its greatest Eastern elongations it may be seen in the West a few minutes after snnset; and when in greatest Western elongations may be seen in the East a few minutes before sunrise.

VENUS will be the Evening Star until July 18, after which it will be

the Morning Star.

Mars will be a Morning Star until July 14, after which it will be an Evening Star.

JUPITER will be an Evening Star until July 31, after which it will be a Morning Star.

SATURN will be a Morning Star until Feb. 11, after which it will be an Evening Star until Aug. 23, and thereafter a Morning Star.
