Marbiehead, Mass., July 2.—The schooner Corona, owned by A. F. Lukes, crossed the finish line of the Eastern Yacht Club's 180-mile course, ocean race, from New London to this port, at 3.28.01 a.m. to-day, thus winning the principal cup in the event, She made the run in 33 hours 48 minutes and 1 second. At 8 a.m., none of the other boats were in sight.

Five hours after the Corona, Francis Skinner's schooner Constellation finished, and an hour later Vice-Commodore F. Lawis Clark's schooner Emerald came in. The other hoats which made up the fleet of nine which started from New London either abandoned the race or were compelled to withdraw because of accidents.
