THE COUNTY OF SIMCOE

Consists of the Townships of "*Adjala, Essa, Flos, West Gwillimbury, Innisfil, Matchedash, Medonte, Nottawasaga, Orillia, Oro, Sunnidale, Tay, Tecumseth, Tiny, Tossorontio and Vespra*, including the Islands in Lake Simcoe and the Georgian Bay, lying wholly or for the most part opposite to the said County of Simcoe, or any part thereof, and contiguous thereto. The Towns of *Barrie, Collingwood, Orillia, Penetanguishene, Stayner, Midland*, and *Alliston*, and the Villages of *Beeton, Bradford, Creemore and Tottenham*."
