It is to be regretted that the clergy do not send to the Society more detailed accounts of their parochial work and of the many interesting events which must occur in their yearly routine. The Annual Report might then be made more valuable both to the clergy and the laity.

The Executive Committee gladly note the increase in some of the returns. ALBION MINES.—The returns including special collection to make up the Block Sum, are nearly fifty per cent. more than in the year 1870. ANNAPOLIS.—Although the usual amount from this parish has not been received, yet the district of Rosette has sent more than in the previous year. ANTIGONISHE has slightly increased its contribution. ARICHAT.—The Committee regret to find that no return has been made from this mission. BARRINGTON.—No return has been received for the past two years. BEAVER HARBOR.—No return was made in 1870, but for the present year the amount has nearly reached the average return. BRIDGEWATER has sent three times the amount of last year's return. CHESTER has slightly increased its contributions to the general purposes of the Society. CORNWALLIS and HORTON.—This parish has sent in fifty per cent. more than in 1870. DARTMOUTH has sent in a larger return than in the previous year although the district of the Eastern Passage has been set apart as a separate parish. DIGBY has sent \$44.40, whereas the return for 1870 was \$27.50. EASTERN PASSAGE, formerly included in Dart-
