RE: Band Farm - Kehiwin Reserve.

I am enclosing herewith copy of letter received from Mr. Nissen, Clerk-in-Charge, Saddle Lake Agency, advising that the Kehiwin Band Council have decided to abandon the development of a seed farm on their reserve as insufficient cooperation was received from the band members and the \$500.00 authorized for expenditure in paying for wages, gas and oil was not spent in 1954.

The council are now asking that they be authorized to expend an amount of \$396.72 of band funds for the purchase of a No. 5 John Deere 3 Bottom 14" Stubble Plow for use in doing custom work for the Indians in conjunction with the John Deere tractor which they are now using for this purpose.
