MISCELLANEOUS.

When word was received of the formation of a Branch of our Society for Manitoba and the North-West Territories, the Executive sent greetings to it, and it was decided that it be at liberty to choose the time most convenient for the holding of its annual meeting.

A committee was appointed to wait on the editor of the Christian Guardian to see if a later date could not be a ranged for the printing of the W.M.S. column, but reported that Mr. Courtice found it impossible to make any change.

The stenographic report of the proceedings of the last Board meeting having been received and read, it was resolved on account of its incompleteness not to accept it as an official report.

A committee was appointed to prepare forms to be filled in by the homes aided or supported by our Society, a draft of these forms to be submitted to this Board for approval. A committee was appointed to revise "Instructions to Missionaries" and "Questions to Missionary Applicants." This committee also to report to the Board.

As the work of the Corresponding Secretary has grown too heavy for one, at the request of Mrs. Strachan, the Executive gave notice of motion to amend the constitution to admit of the appointment of two Corresponding Secretaries.

In reference to the circular letters sent to members of the Executive when questions need to be submitted between meetings, it was decided not to have the questions contained therein put in the form of resolutions.

The request of the World's Convention of Christian Women that our Society should appoint the 15th of November as a day of prayer was acceded to.
