Honestly Working for Good of Country as Whole -Problem of Reconstruction Formidable.

Mexico City, July 5—Among the many problems to be faced by the present government if it is to "make good" is that of preventing the wholesale emigration of its citizens, rich and poor, across the Rio Grande. This has been going on for a considerable time past and within the past few weeks it has reached such a pitch that the authorities are compelled to bestir themselves and only today have sent somewhat belated orders to the frontier officials to report on the best way of checking it.

The underlying troublesome truth is that of recent years Mexico has not been a desirable dwelling place either for the rich or the poor, for the native or the foreigner. The man with any visible property at all was always liable to have it taken away from him more or less violently, without any prospect whatever of getting it back.

I came across an example of this only this morning by one of those co-incidences which of recent years have almost ceased to be remarkable. I was introduced, that is to say, to an Englishman and we recognized each other as having last met in an unpleasant village in Flanders in 1917. This is his story:

The outsider might not unnaturally suppose that these emigrants go to the United States because they find it profitable, and that the chief objection from the Mexican point of view lies in from the Mexican point of view lies in the loss of their labor and its results. An official of the department of labor, with whom I have discussed the matwith whom I have discussed the matter, assures me that there is another side to it. The ministry is continually receiving complaints of the treatment which the Mexican immigrant receives at the hands of "agents" who profess to be able to find them work, tempt them across the border and there hold them

across the border and there hold them in a species of slavery, the commonest modus operandi being to sell them necessities while they are awaiting employment, charging them such enormous prices that however good their employment they are never subsequently able to get out of debt.

As a result hundreds, or even thousands, of Mexicans are now penniless in the United States, particularly in Arizona, and President de la Huerta has now given instructions to all Mexican consuls that all such unfortunates are to be provided with free accommodation and transport back to their homes. 


