FREE TIME LIMIT IS EXTENDED

Protest of Board of Trade and Commercial Club Results in Ten Days on Shipments Now Instead of Five.

The protest of the Board of Trade and Commercial Club concerning matter of demurrage on lumber charged by the railways after a certain time has resulted in a change of the regulations on this question. Instructions from headquarters were received by L. R. Ross, terminal agent for the C. N. R., today notifying him of the change, which is to the effect that the free time allowance on the export of lumber has been allowed to continue at the old period of ten days, exclusive of Sundays and holidays. The period had been reduced to five days on lumber shipments and it was felt that this was not sufficient as there is generally some delay in their clearance either because of car congestion or through berth occupancy, lack of facilities or some other reason. The change will give satisfaction to lumber exporters.

BRITISH COLUMBIA'S FINANCES.
Victoria, B. C., Feb. 5.—Surplus of revenue over expenditure on current accounts amounting to \$1,043,254 is indicated in the public accounts tabled in the legislature yesterday by Hon. John Hart, minister of finance for British Columbia. The total revenue from all sources during the year amounted to \$1,000,479, and the total expenditure of current account was \$9,887,744.

William Searle.

THE INFLUENZA SITUATION IN THE PROVINCE

(Special to Times.)

Fredericton, Feb. 5.—Further reports of cases of epidemic of influenza in New Brunswick have been received as follows by the department of health: Several at St. John city, twelve in Queens county, sub-district chiefly about Cady's, ten scattered throughout Kings county, six at Miramichi county. The cases in Kings county are at Sussex, White Head, Torriburn and Kingsbury. Before Mr. Justice White in the chancery court this morning the case of John N. Jordan vs. George F. Burden, Annie M. Burden, his wife, and Edward E. Burden, his son, was begun.

R. B. Hanson, K. C., and C. D. Richards appeared for the plaintiff and L. J. Hughes for the defendant.

The suit is for declaration of title that Jordan is the equitable owner of a tract of land in the parish of Queensbury, York county, standing in the name of Mrs. Burden, also for damages for lumber cut upon it by the defendants and for a junction against further cutting of lumber by them.
