During the summer 1846, there were admitted 72 cases of Fractures, among which were :

Among the operations performed during the summer 1846 were those of Amputation, Lithotomy, Hernia, Trephine, Ligature of femoral and other vessels, Removal of the head of the Humerus, and of various tumours, &c.
