

**EBERTS, Hon. DAVID McEWEN, Q.C. (South Victoria).**

B. in Chatham, Ont., in 1850. M., 1886, dau. of Mr. Wm. Charles. Settled in Victoria in 1878, and was called to the Bar, B.C., 1880. Apptd. Q.C. Is a Bencher of the Law Soc. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e., 1890, and re-elected 1894. A Conservative.—*Victoria, B.C.*

**FORSTER, THOMAS (Westminster, Delta Riding).**

B. near Hexham, Northumberland, Eng., and ed. there. Unmarried. Is a farmer. First returned to Leg. Assem. for Nanaimo at g. e., 1890. Re-elected for present seat at g. e., 1894. A Liberal.—*Clayton, B.C.*

**GRAHAM, DONALD (East Yale).**

Fourth s. of Alex. Graham of Ardallin, Sutherlandshire, Scot. B. there, 23 April, 1848, and ed. at Taio, Ross-shire. Came to Can. in 1865. M., 7 Jan., 1885, Miss Adelaide Grier. Is a farmer and a J.P., and has been Reeve of Spallamacheen for three terms. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e., 1894. A Conservative.—*Armstrong P.O., B.C.*

**HELMCKEN, HARRY DALLAS, Q.C. (Victoria City).**

Second s. of Hon. J. S. Helmcken, a former officer of the Hudson Bay Company, and a mem. of the Crown Colony Govt. of B.C. B. in Victoria, 22 Dec., 1859. Ed. in B.C. and in Eng. M., 1895. Called to the Bar B.C., 1883, and apptd Q.C. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e., 1894. A Liberal-Conservative.—*Victoria, B.C.*

**HIGGINS, Hon. DAVID WILLIAMS (Esquimalt).**

Fourth s. of William B. Higgins, a native of Manchester, Eng., who settled in N.S. in 1814, and removed to U.S. in 1836. B. in Halifax, N.S., 30 Nov., 1834. M., 1863, at Victoria, B.C., Mary J. Pidwell, a native of Charlottetown, P.E.I. Ed. at Brooklyn, N.Y. Founded at San Francisco, in 1856, the *Morning Call* newspaper, which he sold in 1858, when he removed to B.C. Was for twenty-five years editor and proprietor of the *Colonist* newspaper, Victoria. Organized and was first Presdt. of the Victoria Fire Dept.; mem. and chairman of the Board of Education in B.C., 1866-69, and again in 1884-6, and has been a mem. of the City Council and School Board of Victoria. Is Presdt. of the National Electric Tramway Co. of Victoria. First
