President: Provided, that one month's notice of the same shall be given Proviso. in the Canada Gazette, and in at least one newspaper in each electoral division, or, in the absence of such newspaper, the nearest division.

VII. The officers of the Corporation shall be, ex officio, members of Court of Extended Standards, which shall meet on the first Wednesday of aminers of April and October of each year, at such place as the Council may by Students or By-law fix, for the purpose of examining all candidates desirous of practitioners. enrolling themselves as students, or obtaining license to practise the Medical profession in Upper Canada, and shall, under the signature of the President and Secretary and Seal of the Corporation, grant a license Licenses to be to such candidate, which shall be the only legal license to practise the granted. Medical profession in Upper Canada, and for the same shall be entitled to demand a fee of not more than \$50; Provided that,

1. All examinations shall be open and by written questions and Mode of examination.

2. All persons now resident in Upper Canada, and who are by the Persons entiprovisions of Act or Acts or clauses of any Act hereby repealed, entitled that the design to license in Upper Canada, but who have neglected to procure the same, lected to promay avail themselves of the Acts or parts of any Act or Acts repealed cure licenses. 20 at any time within six months from the passing of this Act.

VIII. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
