C A P. XVI.

An Act to allow the Importation of Rum and other Spirits, from the Island of *Bermuda* into the Province of *Lower Canada* without Payment of Duty, on the same Terms and Conditions as such Importation may be made directly from His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in the *West Indies*.

[24th March 1809.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient that a Commercial Intercourse should be encouraged between the Province of *Lower Canada* and the Island of *Bermuda*, and between the latter and His Majesty's Sugar Colonies in the *West Indies* : And whereas certain Duties on Rum and other Spirits imported into *Canada* are imposed by an Act of the Fourteenth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to establish a Fund towards further defraying the Charges of the Administration of Justice and Support of the Civil Government within the Province of Quebec in America* ; which Duties are, under certain Conditions and Restrictions, remitted by an Act of the Twenty-eighth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to allow the Importation of Rum or other Spirits from His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in the West Indies into the Province of Quebec without Payment of Duty, under certain Conditions and Restrictions* ; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty,
