The undersigned,  
 William & William, of the Township  
 of Caradoc in the County of  
 Middlesex having duly apply to  
 lease for a term of ten years  
 from the first day of January  
 1893 the 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of the 1<sup>st</sup> of  
 lot 8 in Range 2 Caradoc  
 Reserve upon the following conditions  
 Receiving the School lot now  
 on the place for school purposes  
 This lot contains 49<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> acres  
 To pay a Cash rental of fifty  
 dollars a year. The rent for  
 the first three years and one  
 half to be paid in advance  
 afterwards half yearly in advance  
 To lay out and repair all  
 the fences and keep them in repair  
 at a valuation of one hundred  
 dollars. To make 200 rods  
 of ditching sufficiently large  
 to properly drain the land  
 of surface water into the  
 large drain to the west of  
 the lot at a valuation of  
 fifty dollars. To perform  
 the usual staple labor  
 and use the land in a  
 good husbandlike manner  
 and fence the land off  
 into three equal fields  
 the fences to run  
 each.
