Dear Dr. Amyot:

I have your note of July 9th, with enclosure from Dr. John K. McLeod, City Medical Officer of Sydney, N.S. The conditions on this reserve are well known to us, and we have had for some time under consideration a plan for locating these Indians elsewhere, but have not yet decided on a satisfactory site.

It may be possible for the Honorable the Superintendent General to visit this locality this year, and if so I intend to accompany him. We can undertake no expenditure this fiscal year because we have no Parliamentary appropriation, but we are endeavouring to keep the little reserve in a sanitary condition.
