Flying all day and night to 0530 hours 13-5-41. No. R63898 Sgt. Boswell W.H. remanded for Court Martial 1000 hours 16-5-41.	
" "	13-5-41		Wing Commander D. H. MacCaul visited the Station. Good flying day. Ceiling and visibility unlimited. Night flying.	
" "	14-5-41		Ceiling and visibility unlimited to make good flying weather. Night Flying also. F/Lt. B.C. Andrew and Passenger LAC. Stuart ferried Nomad 3508 to No. 11 Technical Detachment, Cartier-ville. Burial of six RAF from vault to Air Force Plots in Barrie Cemetery, also LAC. Kel-loway of Newfoundland at 1400 hours. Minister of National Defence, Hon. Col. J.L. Ralston arrived by air at 1015 hours, proceeded to inspect Armoured Division in Military Area, left for Ottawa by air at 1630 hours.	
" "	15-5-41		Visibility limited.--no night flying. 400638 LAC Sharpe W. G. (RAAF) ground looped Yale 3413 damaging oleo leg and wing. Several Officers reported in for District Court Martial.
