I have also to report for your Excellency's information, that the same claim to this Signement was formerly made by the Indians in the Year 1789 and then referred by Lord Dorchester to a Committee of the whole Council who after examination reported on the 21st of April that no satisfactory evidence had been given to the Committee of any title granted to the Indians either by the French Crown or by any grantee of that Crown."
