Dear Sir:-

Answering your letter of the 25th., I have no objection to your using my letter of February 20th. in any way you may see fit.

I feel that my actions during the past 21 years have shown that I have the interests of the farmers of Canada at heart, and as to that Mr. A. W. Neill, M. P. can tell you something. If the elimination of the tariff on manufactured fertilizers and Superphosphate were in the interests of agricultural production in Canada, I would never raise my voice against it. Such an enterprise as ours is only of importance so long as it serves a useful purpose in the economic life of the Province and the Dominion, and no industry has a right to existence if it is only a parasite. But the removal of these small imposts was not in the interests of agriculture, and the action was taken either through ignorance, or through the desire to catch votes, at least such is my opinion.
